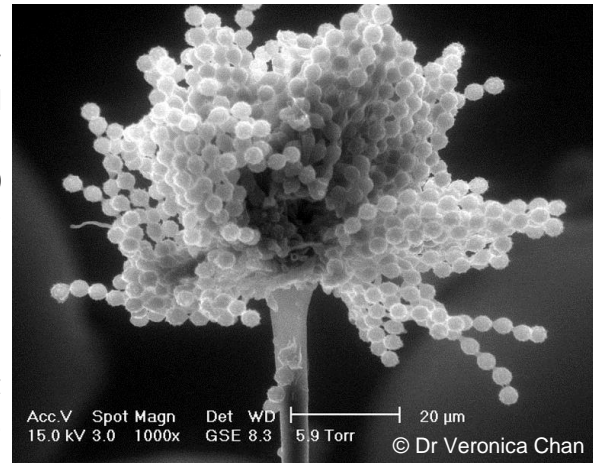

A better understanding of the inspection and management of airborne mould in indoor environment is crucial for the improvement of indoor air quality (“IAQ”) and the minimization of the airborne infection. The World Health Organisation published the IAQ guidelines to address the problem of dampness and mould, and selected pollutants in 2009 and 2010 respectively. Recently, the HKEPD has completed a review of the current IAQ Certification Scheme for Offices and Public Place (‘IAQ Certification Scheme’). The new IAQ objectives, including a new parameter of mould, will be launched on 1 July 2019. This training will provide the participants with all essential knowledge in indoor mould inspection and management and help the participants to prepare for the new IAQ objectives implementation in 2019.
