SUSTAINABLE CONSUMPTION AWARD SCHEME -VOTE NOW !

Supported by the Sustainable Development Fund, BEC Sustainable Consumption Programme aims to promote sustainable consumption and drive behavioural changes in Hong Kong. Since its debut in July 2017, over 200 companies have joined the Programme as a Sustainable Consumption Enterprise or Sustainable Product Supplier. Meanwhile, the **Sustainable Consumption Award Scheme** recognises outstanding companies and organisations that place importance on the environmental and social impacts of the products and services they purchase, and show commitment to offer sustainable options.

BEC has shortlisted the top 12 Sustainable Consumption Enterprises and Sustainable Product Suppliers. Members of public can now vote for their favourite companies from each category. An Award Presentation Ceremony will be hosted on 27 July 2018 in L1 Atrium of D · Park, Tsuen Wan which marks the first anniversary of the Programme and commends businesses for their participation to help foster a sustainable future. An educational exhibition will also be held alongside to promulgate the concept of sustainable consumption.

What are LEED and WELL?

LEED (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) is one of the most widely used green building rating system worldwide. Available for nearly all building project types, LEED certification provides independent verification of a building's green features, allowing for the design, construction, operations and maintenance of resource-efficient, high-performing, healthy, environmentally responsible buildings. LEEDcertified buildings typically use fewer resources and consume less energy and water than conventional buildings. Nearly 80,000 projects are participating in LEED across 160 countries.

On the other hand, the WELL Building Standard is a rating system for measuring, certifying, and monitoring features of the built environment that impact human health and wellbeing, through air, water, nourishment, light, fitness, comfort, and mind. WELL was developed based on medical research that explores the connection between the buildings where we spend more than 90% of our time, and the health and wellness of its occupants. Launched in 2014, nearly 900 projects are participating in WELL across 34 countries.

Green Building forms an integral part of our focus areas at BEC. We help businesses implement the latest technology to upgrade the performance of building and remain competitive in a low carbon world. We provide green building certification advisory services, including BEAM Plus, LEED, and WELL.

BEC Corporate Member Grosvenor Limited recently celebrated the recipient of dual LEED and WELL Gold for new and existing interiors for its Hong Kong office refurbishment, the first project in Hong Kong of its kind to receive the recognition. The key aim of the project was to put the wellbeing of its employees first, but also create a more productive and engaging working environment by adopting sustainable practices while reducing operating costs.

BEC Council Member Gammon **Construction** recently completed Phase One of its Global Switch Hong Kong data centre project, which

meets best-in-class operational and environmental management performance standards. Design for Manufacture and Assembly (DfMA) and off-site modularisation approaches were used to reduce waste, energy and risk. A prime example was the installation of modularised weldless plant rooms. Building Information Modelling was fully utilised from conceptual design stage to help eliminate potential clashes that could lead to costly and wasteful rework. A new energy efficient system of diesel rotary uninterruptable power supply was also installed - the first of its kind in Hong Kong with such scale - that made optimum use of space, simplified design and installation, and provided future flexibility for adaptation.

The discussion featured speakers from International Capital Market Association, Climate Bonds Initiative, S&P Global Ratings, BNP Paribas, Link Asset Management, and New World Development discussing market developments and the evolving set of green finance frameworks. Three key points arose from the discussion: climate risk and opportunities can affect credit ratings of financial products, the green finance market is growing rapidly, and that finance plays a critical role to transitioning to a low carbon future.
