BEC LOW CARBON CHARTER: FIRST ANNIVERSARY AND ACHIEVEMENTS

BEC hosted a webinar on 15 May to mark the first anniversary of the launch of the BEC Low Carbon Charter. We celebrated the progress and achievements of the current signatories, and introduced new companies and organisations who have agreed to sign onto this journey. More than 220 participants joined the webinar. The guest of honour **Mr C.W. Tse, Under Secretary for the Environment**, mentioned that combating climate change is a challenging task which cannot be tackled by the Government alone. Contributions from the entire community are instrumental to achieving this important goal. He also thanked all the support from BEC. Representatives from two of the signatories, namely Mr M.K. Leung of Ronald Lu & Partners (Hong Kong) Limited and Mr Bobby Chau of Shiu Wing Steel Limited, shared their insights on setting targets, developing and operationalising decarbonisation plans.

To date, a total of 64 companies and organisations have already pledged to the BEC Low Carbon Charter. 57 of them are committed to Pathway 1, while 7 of them to Pathway 2. To walk the talk and lead by example, BEC also signed onto the Charter and will join force with other signatories to begin our decarbonisation journey.

To create buzz prior to the webinar, BEC prepared a series of six promotional videos of the BEC Low Carbon Charter featuring **BEC Chairman Mr Richard Lancaster**, **BEC Deputy Chairman Mr Eric Chong**, Director of the HK Observatory Dr C.M. Cheng, Convenor of the Support Group on Long-term Decarbonisation Strategies Mr C.Y. Lam, Ms Julie Wong of NWS Holdings Limited and Mr Andy Yeung of Hongkong Land (Property Management) Limited. Altogether the videos aim to give the audience a key message: Are you ready to go low carbon?

Green Delight in Estates

BEC has partnered with The Hong Kong Housing Authority (HA) to organise the community environmental programme “Green Delight in Estates” (GDE) since 2012. The programme aims to raise environmental awareness of Public Rental Housing residents and instil a culture of environmental protection and improvement.

During GDE Phase 12 from January 2019 to January 2021, BEC organises **Green Living Day** for 23 public housing estates, home to over 114,000 households! Through game booths, second-hand barter markets, upcycling and eco-detergent workshops, residents can familiarise themselves with green concepts such as recycling, waste reduction and waste separation at source. To help develop a habit of recycling, BEC holds **Recycling Day** in the same estate on the same day every month for 6 months. Residents can also further enhance their knowledge by participating in our **Eco Tour** to visit various green facilities around Hong Kong, such as CIC-Zero Carbon Park, WEEE·PARK and T·PARK.

Amid a significant drop in the number of confirmed COVID-19 cases recently, BEC will soon resume all GDE planned and corporate volunteering activities. Stay tuned!

The new target will focus on achieving absolute emissions and take into account various emissions reductions opportunities. These include accelerating the transition from a diesel to an electric-powered airside vehicle and ground services equipment fleet, and seeking zero carbon electricity from the grid. The study will encourage the whole airport community and the key energy parties to work together to achieve decarbonisation as a key component of Hong Kong's low carbon economy.
