In the process of gas pipelines works, scrap PE pipes and fittings are generated. BEC Council Member **The Hong Kong and China Gas Company Limited (Towngas)** upcycled these waste materials to create “Waste-to-Treasure Solar Powered Hydroponics Systems”, and donated them to 12 primary and secondary schools for scientific investigation.

To cultivate the interest in STEM and foster environmental awareness among our next generation, Towngas organised the “Towngas Inter-School Environmental Scientific Investigation Competition”. Over 60 students of this competition were presented on stage to judges and members of the public at Eco Expo Asia 2019 on 2 November. Winners of the competition demonstrated their outstanding data analysis and problem-solving skills, as well as creativity and environmental awareness.

BEC Corporate Member **Fung Group** has joined forces with leading global companies to sign the Fashion Pact. The pact is a response to the call for action from the fashion industry by President of France, Emmanuel Macron, at the G7 Summit in August. Signatory companies pledged to adopt key goals for addressing climate change, enhancing biodiversity and protecting the ocean. Fung Group is one of the initial signatories and, as of October, a total of 56 companies have joined the coalition, representing around 250 brands globally. LF Logistics, one of the business units under Fung Group, has recently signed a pledge prohibiting the use of Arctic routes for shipping products from Asia. Although LF Logistics does not currently use Arctic routes, this initiative closely aligns with the group's commitment to contributing to the protection of the planet.

Delighting You Always

Environmental protection and waste reduction are crucial aspects in achieving sustainability. As an environmentally conscious organisation, BEC Corporate Member **Canon Hongkong Company Limited (CHK)** envisions a sustainable future and advocates a greener way in its business operations. For instance, CHK has run “Ink Cartridge Recycling Programme” and invited the local famous cartoon character “McDull” as the programme's ambassador since 2009. As of August 2019, over 206,000 pieces of empty ink cartridges have been collected from over 295 collection points, with over 4.9 tons of plastics recycled through this programme. This has led to a reduction of over 7.5 tons of CO2 emission, which will require 317 trees to absorb for a year.

In order to enhance awareness among students, CHK also extended the Ink Cartridge Recycling Programme to education sectors and organised “Canon x McDull Inter-school Ink Cartridge Recycling Competition” to encourage active participation from schools. The programme is now open for enrolment and schools are invited to join this meaningful programme while competing for fabulous prizes.


Policy Dialogue Series

BEC Industry Visit to HKRITA

18 December



BEC is organising an industry visit to **The Hong Kong Research Institute of Textiles and Apparel Limited (HKRITA)** on 18 December. HKRITA has developed technologies to recycle old clothes into quality textile fibres to be used for re-production of various textiles and products, including yarn, fabric, and garments. The hydrothermal treatment process uses only heat, water and less than 5% of a biodegradable green chemical to achieve a recovery rate of over 98% for polyester fibres. This visit aims to promote the importance of recycling and provide insights to implementing circular economy in Hong Kong.
