Effective Environmental, Social and Governance (ESG) management, encompassing the concepts of Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR), helps create shared value for both business and society, and build sustainable economies. Apart from ethical reasons, ESG management is also fundamental for companies to build resilience against corporate risks and create long-term shareholder value.

Many investors are increasingly concerned about how sustainable a company's business model is and are taking a more holistic approach in their due diligence by incorporating ESG considerations during the process. In addition to becoming increasingly relevant to investors, sustainability performance information will also be material to wider stakeholders. Better ESG management and disclosure among Hong Kong businesses may enable Hong Kong to attract more capital, outperform our counterparts, enhance our competitiveness; and thus, escalate our status as an international financial centre.

The business community needs to be part of the conversation in shaping the policies for future market practice. In this Conference, BEC will bring together market regulators, business leaders, private equity firms, financial institutions, and industry professionals to review current market practice, and to drive decision-making that is beneficial to investors, corporates and wider society.
